

MY BIG WORDS SPELLING STRATEGY

Remember: A syllable needs to have a vowel

1. Say the word and think if it is a compound word
2. If it is not a compound word, listen for parts of the words you know; think of the origin of the word
3. Listen if there is a prefix or suffix and think of the word's meaning
4. Write the prefix
5. Break the base word in syllables. Say and spell each syllable
6. Add the suffix and edit spelling if needed
7. Read the word and compare with the word you intended to spell
 - a. Check your syllables have a vowel
 - b. Check if you need to have a double consonant
8. Revise as needed and be flexible
